Responsibilities

In this position you are expected to:

- Assist in planning and conducting RunJumpThrow programs, including setup, and packing up of equipment each day.
- Be able to build a healthy rapport with children, parents and City of Toronto staff.
- Instruct children in RunJumpThrow tasks activities and lead/supervise off-site field trips.
- Keep the children you are responsible for under constant supervision.
- Create a positive, safe and supportive environment for all campers.
- Act as an appropriate role model for the children through your actions, language, work habits and general conduct.
- Be a team player and collaborate with fellow staff in a professional manner.
- Have the ability to positively motivate children.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Membership in the Ontario Track and Field Association an asset
- Must be registered as a full time student this school year and intend to return to school full time for the next school year
- Must have own transportation or access to transportation within Toronto
- Must be available for NCCP training as a RunJumpThrow instructor
- Must successfully pass a criminal record check
- Should have some experience with, or a strong interest in working with young children
- First Aid/CPR or completion of an NCCP coaching course would be an asset
